2018 S.T.E.P.S.- Have you been asking, "What is this S.T.E.P.S. thing anyway?" The acronym stands for Studying, Teaching, Equipping, Praying, and Serving and is the annual faith formation and leader development event sponsored by Charleston Atlantic Presbytery. S.T.E.P.S. is open to all members of the 47 churches who make up our presbytery. Participants have an opportunity to take part in three workshop sessions, worship together, fellowship over lunch, visit displays of various organizations and institutions in order to learn about their ministries, and shop at the bookstore. 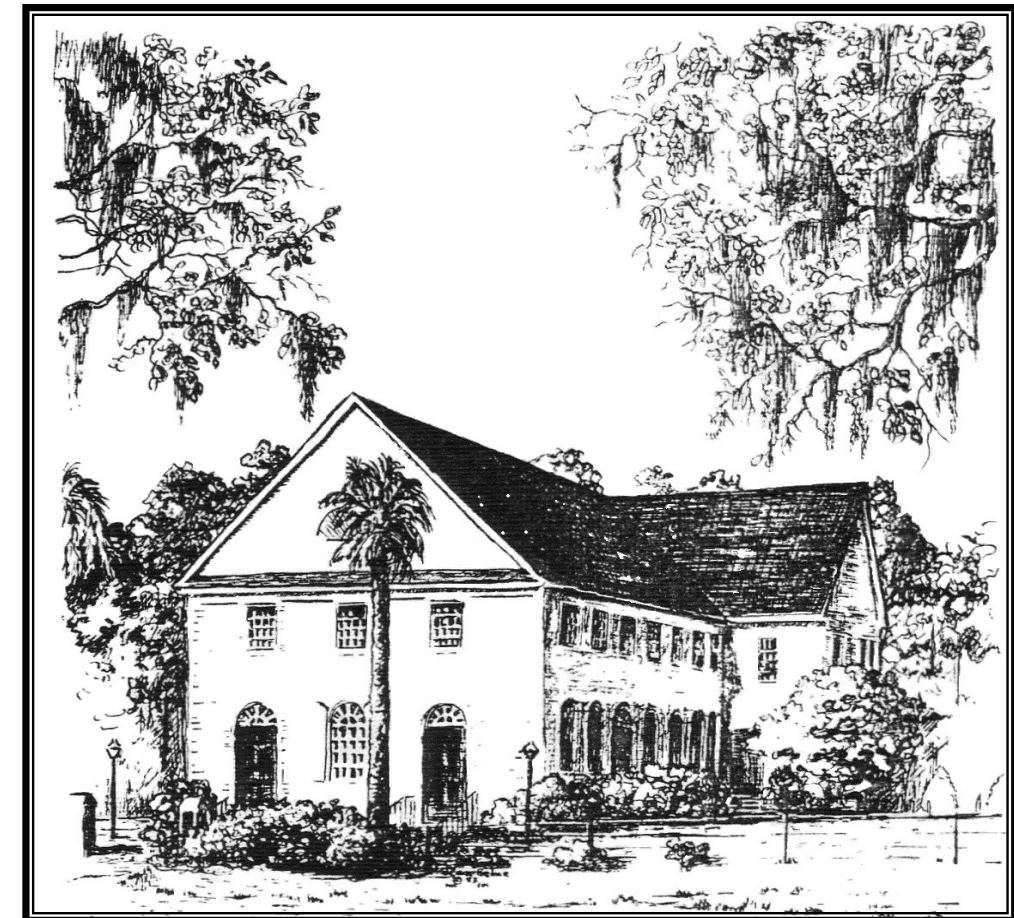
