



## Children and Family Prayer Guide



### Our Scripture reading today is Matthew 22: 15-22,

Some of the other leaders want to trick Jesus into telling people to do something that will get him arrested. So they ask him whether or not people should pay taxes to the government.

If Jesus says that people should NOT pay their taxes to the government, he will be arrested. If Jesus tells the people they SHOULD pay their taxes, these leaders hope people will stop believing in him and stop following him.

But Jesus knows they are trying to trick him. He says that people should "give to God what belongs to God, and give to the government what belongs to the government. "




The Pharisees planned to trap Jesus in His word. Who did they send to Jesus?


